

# ■ Leather RFID Wallets for Men – Inspection Checklist

## Before Buying:

- ■ Check stitching — even, tight, no loose threads.
- ■ Inspect lining seams — no gaps or fraying.
- ■ Test card slot tension — snug but not overly tight.
- ■ Look for “RFID-blocking lining” mentioned on tag/packaging.
- ■ Ask about warranty or guarantee for RFID protection.
- ■ Examine weight & thickness — comfortable in pocket.
- ■ Count card slots & compartments — does it meet your needs?
- ■ Check cash compartment fit — bills slide in flat, no folding.
- ■ ID window placement — clear, easy to access.
- ■ Avoid strong magnetic closures (they may damage cards).

## Care & Maintenance:

- ■ Don’t overstuff — keeps leather + RFID lining intact.
- ■ Keep wallet dry — avoid water, sweat, or excessive heat.
- ■ Clean leather with mild soap & conditioner (never harsh chemicals).
- ■ Avoid ironing or bending over card slots (protect RFID layer).
- ■ Inspect metallic lining periodically for wear.

## Long-Term Use:

- ■ Register or note warranty terms.
- ■ Repair scratches/scuffs early (adds character, prevents damage).
- ■ Use artisan leather repair shops if needed.
- ■ Replace only when RFID lining is worn out or leather is cracked.
